

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF WOODVILLE, MISSISSIPPI

The Board of Aldermen of Woodville, Mississippi took up for consideration the need for Board action to express its choice as to certain code requirements of SB No. 2378, Mississippi Legislature, 2014 Regular Session. After full discussion of the subject, Alderman Fry offered and moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN (“BOARD”) OF WOODVILLE, MISSISSIPPI (“CITY”) CHOOSING NOT TO SUBJECT THE CITY TO THE CODE REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED UNDER SB NO. 2378, MISSISSIPPI LEGISLATURE, 2014 REGULAR SESSION.

WHEREAS, the Board of the City hereby finds, determines and declares as follows:

I.

Senate Bill No. 2378, passed in the 2014 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature, Section 1, subsection 1, mandates that all Mississippi municipalities shall adopt and amend as minimum construction codes one of several codes set forth in SB 2378; and

II.

Section 1, subsection 3 of SB No. 2378 provides that within one hundred twenty (120) days after the provisions of SB 2378 go into effect on August 1, 2014, the board of aldermen of any city, upon resolution duly adopted and entered upon its minutes, may choose not to be subject to the code requirements imposed under Section 1, subsection 1; and

III.

The Town of Woodville hereby makes its choice not to be bound by the code mandates imposed under Section 1, subsection 1, of SB No. 2378.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the City that it exercises its authority to choose not to be bound by the construction code mandates of SB No. 2378, Section 1, subsection 1.

Following the reading of the foregoing resolution, Alderman Anthony seconded the motion for its adoption. The Mayor put the question to a vote and the members voted unanimously to adopt the Resolution.

The motion having received the unanimous affirmative vote of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Woodville, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted, on this the 5 day of August, 2014.
